

KHN Plasma Donation Screening Information for Physicians and Advance Practice Providers

- Confirmed positive COVID-19 patients will receive communication regarding their opportunity to be a potential plasma donor.
- Potential donors will be instructed to contact KHN Plasma Donation Screening Line (937) 762-5839. This line will be answered daily by a Nurse Practitioner.
- Potential donors will be screened for the confirmation of COVID-19 results as well as symptom resolution including overall blood donation criteria per Community Blood Center standards
- If patient is determined to be a plasma donation candidate, the following actions will occur:
 - Online forms for Community Blood Center is completed by APP performing screening:

 - Form CS-410-F-02 will be completed, signed, and faxed to Community Blood Center <http://givingblood.org/media/58272/Instructions%20for%20Qualifying%20a%20COVID-19%20Plasma%20Donor.pdf>
 - Community Blood Center will then reach out to patient to schedule a time for them to donate plasma.
 - Nurse Practitioner will complete any required orders needed.
